

US Alpine Masters 2019 Phillips 66 Eastern Championships Regional Champions Team (Men)

The US Alpine Masters Regional Champions team is selected from the competitors in each class with the greatest total of World Cup points from their finishes in both events of the championship. The 2019 Eastern Championships were hosted by New England masters at Stratton Mountain, VT on Jan. 26-27, 2019.

Eligibility: Competitors must have a current US masters membership to be eligible for the overall regional class champion award and compete in both the GS and SL. Short-term memberships are not eligible for participation in regional or national championships.

Tiebreaker Notes

There was one tie in the overall combined standings for regional champion in the men's classes at the 2019 Eastern Championships. In M09, Eric Cutting (EA) and Terry Hanna (CAN) were tied at 45 points, each with 1-2 finishes, but Hanna was competing with a short-term membership and not eligible for the regional champions team.
